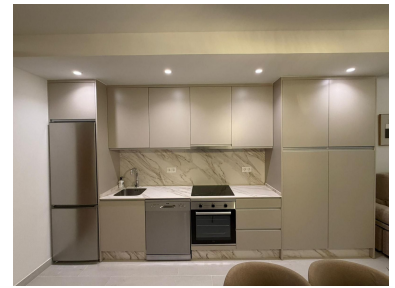

Montemar and La Carihuela are both easy to reach via the Paseo. Montemar's known for its lively (and budget-friendly) bars and entertainment.
